CocoCay®, Bahamas

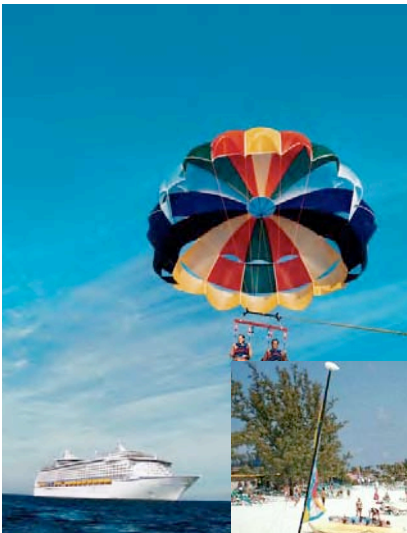

DEPOSIT AND PAYMENTS: Your reservation deposit of \$200 per cabin (\$50 per person is nonrefundable) is official upon receiving your credit card number. The payment schedule is as follows: \$200 deposit per cabin due on June 1, 2009.

Final Payment is due on February 2, 2010.

All payments will be charged to the credit card on record by due date unless otherwise notified.

CANCELLATIONS: All cancellation requests must be submitted in writing and addressed to Zenith Travel. Failure to appear for embarkation for any reason constitutes a cancellation subject to full penalties. Cancellation penalties will be charged as follows:

- Deposit until February 2, 2010 \$50 per person
- February 3 to Mar 30, 2010 Deposit amount
- Mar 31 to Apr 22, 2010 50% of fare
- April 23 to April 30, 2010 No refund
